#### RECESS AND ACTIVITIES: WEATHER

With the cold weather approaching, this is a kind reminder that students are to dress appropriately for the weather. Recess is important to children to provide a break from regular school routine, a chance to get some fresh air. We will only cancel outdoor recess when Environment Canada determines that the temperature is below -20 degrees Celsius (including wind chill) or during wet, rainy days in accordance with District Procedures. Air quality is monitored similarly to extreme cold temperatures. The suggested guideline is that students do not go outside when air quality reaches an index of 7 or more. Whenever outdoor recess is cancelled, an inside, supervised recess break will occur.

The Holy Child Christmas Market is a very special annual event on **Wednesday**, **Dec 20** and **Thursday**, **Dec 21**, **2023** where students have the opportunity to 'shop' for Christmas presents for their families. At the market, students select gifts from donated items which are then wrapped by volunteers and taken home for Christmas morning.

Each year students take great care in selecting the "perfect gifts" for their family members. They express great joy in telling why they selected the gifts they did and excitement in the anticipation of their loved ones' reactions to their gifts.

#### **DONATIONS**

Holy Child families are asked to donate new or gently used items for the Market. There is no set limit on the amount you can donate, however it is suggested that you donate at least one item per person your child will be buying for (ex; if your child is buying for 4 family members we ask that you donate at least 4 items).

Donations will be collected at school December 4th-18th. Send your items to school with your child or bring them to the front entrance of the school and drop them in the Rubbermaid bins provided.

Donations of wrapping paper, tissue paper, bows, and gift bags are also greatly welcomed.

<u>SUGGESTIONS FOR NEW OR GENTLY USED DONATION ITEMS</u>: toys, games, craft items, scrapbook supplies, aprons, place mats, puzzles, baby toys, picture frames, books, posters, candles, candle holders, vases, jewelry, etc.

PLEASE NOTE: for health reasons we cannot accept unsealed make up, clothing, pierced earrings, shoes, hairbrushes, or hair accessories. Please do not send movies, games, magazines or books that have inappropriate messages, pictures or themes. Stuffed animals are welcome but they must be clean and very gently loved.

WE ANTICIPATE BEING SHORT OF GIFTS FOR DADS, TEENS AND BROTHERS. Suggestions for donations: golf balls & tees, hats, tools, ties, coffee mugs, candy, CDs, movies, games, etc.

**All items must be clean and in good shape.** (ex; ensure all puzzle pieces are included) Remember, the items you donate will be a Christmas gift for a child's loved one, chosen from the heart.

Families are asked to contribute \$0.50 for each item being purchased by their child.
