Each student (family) will book a 10-minute time slot online, dedicated to meaningful goal setting for the remainder of Semester One. These conversations will support student growth and provide a clear focus leading up to the mid-year summary reports on January 27, 2026. Interviews will take place between 12:30 p.m. and 4:30 p.m. and then in the evening from 5:30 p.m. – 7:00 p.m.

#### **Closed Campus**




# Inclement Weather – ECSD's Administrative Procedure

The health and safety of students is a paramount consideration in the organization of outdoor activities and recess.

- 1. Decisions regarding outdoor activities are to take into consideration inclement weather that may result from the following conditions or combination of conditions:
  - 1.1 Continuous rain,
  - 1.2 Extreme wind.
  - 1.3 Extreme cold and/or
  - 1.4 Air Quality
- 2. The suggested guideline is that students do not go outside if the temperature is -20° C or colder, or if the temperature and wind chill factor are -20° C or colder.
  - Environment Canada's weather for Edmonton can be consulted at https://weather.gc.ca/city/pages/ab-50 metric e.html

You may also choose to phone Environment Canada at (780) 468-4940 (English) or (780) 495-2145 (French).

- During inclement weather (e.g. temperatures below -20oC with windchill) students will be permitted in the school at 7:50 am. Indoor supervisors will be assigned to supervise areas inside the school. Outside supervision will still occur.
- Recess will occur indoors during inclement weather. Students will remain in their homeroom classes and schedules may be prepared for classes to access the gym during indoor recess breaks.



- Late arrivals: all students are asked to enter the main doors.
- Students are to re-enter the school at the end of the day if they miss their bus, a sibling forgets to meet the student, etc.
