School Fees

The annual school fees are \$30.00 for Kindergarten students and \$50.00 for students in Grades 1 to 6. School fees are due November 30, 2025.

You may have additional fees to pay for additional grade specific learning resources such as bus passes, field trip etc. We kindly ask that these fees be paid as soon as possible.

Day of the Dead/Dia de los Muertos

The Día de los Muertos (Day of the Dead) is an ancient celebration originating in Mexico and Central America that takes place on November 1 and 2. This vibrant festivity—filled with color, aroma, music, and tradition—has captivated people around the world and was recognized by UNESCO in 2008 as an Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity.

At its heart, *Día de los Muertos* is **not** a somber or frightening occasion, but rather a joyful celebration of life. It invites us to honor and remember loved ones who have passed, while reminding us that life continues through memory, love, and connection.

Tied to the Spanish Bilingual Program's cultural outcomes, this celebration provides a meaningful opportunity for all students at Holy Child to participate in and learn from this rich cultural tradition. Students will engage in hands-on learning experiences that foster appreciation and respect for the diverse cultures of the Spanish-speaking world.
