Closed Campus

At Holy Child, the safety and well-being of our students is our highest priority. Please note that we are a closed campus. For security, all exterior doors remain locked throughout the day, and all visitors must enter using the main entrances (Door 5 or Door 8) and **sign in at the office upon arrival**.

We also kindly ask for your support in recognizing that our teachers are fully dedicated to their students and teaching during the instructional day, from 8:18 a.m. – 3:15 p.m. If you wish to connect with your child's teacher, please arrange a meeting by email so that a dedicated time can be set aside.

We truly value the support of our parent community, and volunteers are always welcome for school events, field trips, and classroom activities. Volunteer opportunities will be arranged by the school and individual teachers as needed, ensuring that all opportunities are well-organized and meaningful.

School Fees

School Fees will be posted on September 15 on your PowerSchool account. The annual school fees are \$30.00 for Kindergarten students and \$50.00 for students in Grades 1 to 6.

You may have additional fees to pay for additional grade specific learning resources such as bus passes, field trip etc.

School fees are due November 30, 2025.

Updating the Office about Changes to After School Transportation Plans

To help us ensure the safety of all students, it is very important that families please inform the school of any changes to their child's after-school transportation plans, particularly if they **will not** be taking the bus on a given day. Keeping an updated list of bus riders allows us to account for every student and ensure they get home safely.

After school:

Supervision times after school are from dismissal at 3:15 pm until 3:30 pm.

(11:43 am until 11:58 am on Thursdays)

We will have a supervisor for buses as well as one for the back (west) field.

Parking Reminders

The designated drop-off zone for our school is located along 111 Street.

To ensure the safety of all students, we kindly ask that parents do not use the staff parking lot for drop-off or pick-up at any time—including when students are arriving late.

If your child is late, please use the main entrance on 110 Street for drop-off.

Additionally, 99 Avenue is reserved for school buses only and should not be used for student drop-off or pick-up


