"But in your hearts reverence Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to make a defense to anyone who calls you to account for the hope that is in you." (1 Peter 3:15)







Important bus Information for parents/guardians: Pick up & Drop off

Thank you to all of our families for a wonderful school start up! A kind reminder regarding bus pick up and drop off times. Please see some important information from our administrative policy:

AP 560 – Student Transportation AP 560.PDF

4.4 It is the responsibility of the parent to ensure that a parent/guardian is available to receive a Kindergarten or Grade I student at the scheduled stop and at the scheduled time. A parent may delegate this responsibility to an older sibling, provided the older sibling is in grade 6 or higher. Parents are responsible for notifying the Principal of the school that this responsibility has been delegated. If a parent or delegate is not at the drop-off location, the bus driver will notify their Dispatch and continue with the route. The child will be returned to the school at the end of the route.

RECESS AND ACTIVITIES: WEATHER

With the colder weather approaching, this is a kind reminder that students are to dress appropriately for the weather, as we have several recesses during the day where students are able to spend time outside. The suggested guideline is that students do not go outside if the temperature is -20° C or colder, or if the temperature and wind chill factor are -20° C or colder. Air quality is to be monitored similar to extreme cold temperatures. The suggested guideline is that students do not go outside when air quality reaches an index of 7 or more. Please see Administrative Policy 131 for more information on the guidelines for outdoor activities.
